Moses liberated the Israeli people from servitude EGYPT.

The period after the take-over (Book of Joshua) is described until shortly before the beginning of the king's time under Saul (ca. 1050 B.C.). It is recorded in [Book of Judges](#). In the first judge year of Eli, Samuel was admitted in his first year. When Eli died in the 97th year, Samuel would be 57 years old, he directed forty years in Israel how King Saul reigned 40 years, proves in [Acts 13:20-21](#). A total of 475 years, Joshua directed 25 years and the judges' time (from Othniel to Eli) lasted about 450 years, Total would be 515 years of the the judges' time. But the judges' time ended under Eli, when the king's time began. The Judges' time of Samuel ceased, When Samuel died at his age of about 97 years, King Saul died at the same time in the war. But 480 years after the Exodus began the king's time of Israel -1056. The king's time of David flourished, when Samuel's judgment ended. It happened **in the four hundred and eightieth year** after the Exodus, that is, in [1 Kings 6:1](#). This is **the third proof** that the Jewish time calculation after taking the land Joshua's from the Judges' time until shortly before the beginning of the king's time agrees well. **It also proves that the king's time -1056 - -586 (until the end of Judah) lasted 470 years.**

Talmud reckons from the creation of the world to after Exodus Egypt **2448 years**.  
 The current calculation is **2451 years**. **The difference is only + 3 years!**

Thus **the further proof** is that the Jewish time calculation according to Talmud from Adam to Exodus Egypt is astonishingly identical with the current calculation.

Frankly, the calculation from Exodus Egypt to 2. Destruction Temple is not clear how Talmud calculates. From where comes the number of 1000 years between 312 BC. and 2448 from Exodus Egypt?  
 The deviation means: Birth of Jesu 4 BC. And 1 year plus to Talmud count together 5.  
 The current calculation shows the **difference of -222 years**.

**222 years** are missing from the current calculation in the Jewish calendar of 3761 years B.C. from the creation of the world.
