As the priests, like Zacharias, served according to the order of the feasts in the temple of Jerusalem, [the birth date Jesu](#) is doubtful, since the calculation is not compatible to the order of the feasts. Zacharias was neither at the Succoth nor at the feast of the Passover when the angel spoke to him, as in Luke. Zacharias served as usual in the temple around the clock. There appeared an angel of the Lord to him, who stood at the right of the incense altar. And Zachariah was frightened when he saw him, and fear fell upon him, ([Luke 1: 11-12](#)). According to the order of the G-d's calendar- see page 1, G-d is the beginning and the end, it is considered why Jeshua was born on **the first day in the first month Nissan** because John was six months older than Jeshua. G-d teach us, Your Time is not my Time. Here is the Time calculation of John and Jeshua's birth not according to the order of priests.

And Mary remained for about three months and then returned to her home. [Luke 1:56](#)

After Sukkot she went home to Nazareth and stayed for 6 months in Nazareth.

Mary stayed about three months to the end Succot, as Elisabeth was in the 6th month pregnant. Elizabeth bore John at the beginning of the seventh month Tishrei. Mary was already in the fourth month and returned to Nazareth. It took another five months, just **at the beginning of the new year Nissan 3978**, Mary bore Jeshua in Bethlehem, so prophetic,
